

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How do I get started in the Program?

A: Anyone can refer to the program. If you are receiving Home Care services, the Home Care Case Coordinators are a helpful resource. Referral forms can also be picked up from the Day Program Coordinator.

Q: How many days can I attend?

A: Most people are registered for two days per week, but the Coordinator will help you determine what would be the best based on your individual needs.

Q: Can people in wheelchairs attend?

A: Yes, they can safely be accommodated.

Q: How do I know I'll be safe at the Program?

A: All Crossroads staff are trained in First Aide and CPR. A staff person with Health Care Aide training is always present.

Q: Where is the Program located?

A: **Camrose** Day Program operates out of the Rosehaven Heritage Building: 4612 - 53 Street.

B: **Wetaskiwin** Day Program operates out of Peace Hills Lodge at 4501 - 60 Street.

The Bethany Group believes that all people deserve to be treated with dignity and respect in an atmosphere of holistic care, cooperation and integrity.

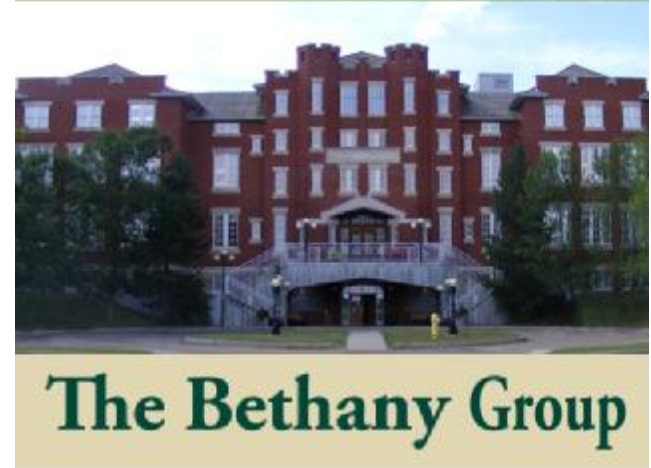
Vision

About Crossroads

The Crossroads Day Program is a service for people in the community who need support and assistance to maintain their independent living situation. Program participants continue to live in their own residence, within the City of Camrose or the City of Wetaskiwin and surrounding areas, and come to the program during the day for a variety of social programs.



Eligibility

In order to be eligible for the program, Day Program clients must:

- Be registered as a Home Care Client
- Have been assessed as requiring a type of Wellness Service
- Be a resident of Alberta
- Be living in the community or in the process of being discharged home
- Have and maintain contact with a physician in the community
- Be motivated to become involved and participate in the program
- Be able to function in a group and not demonstrate behaviour harmful to themselves or others
- Not require constant 1:1 supervision
- Be able to attend on a regular basis



Fees

- There is no daily attendance fee associated with this program.
- There is an \$8.00 per client fee for lunch and snacks.

Services Offered

- Socialization
- Recreation and leisure activities
- Special diets
- Family education and support
- These programs are scheduled from mid-morning to mid-afternoon.
