TIPS Question:

What guidelines would you suggest to a case manager regarding client follow up with a cognitive enhancer? For example, when would you repeat the Folstein once a cognitive enhancer has been started?

Response:

Cognitive enhancers including Aricept, Exelon and Reminyl are all considered helpful to cognition, activities of daily living (ADL), behaviours and caregiver time in assisting and/or supervising patients. It is therefore important to do MMSE or equivalent on monthly basis after a baseline measure is being done. I also suggest to case managers to inquire about the change in ADL (basic and instrumental), behaviour change and the level of caregiver stress at the same time. Ideally a positive change in these domains is certainly encouraging in deciding to continue the cognitive enhancer after the first 6 months trial while watching for side effects, particularly GI symptoms.
