Waiting

Now Thomas, one of the twelve, called the Twin,[d] was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see in his hands the mark of the nails, and place my finger into the mark of the nails, and place my hand into his side, I will never believe." Eight days later, his disciples were inside again, and Thomas was with them. Although the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here, and see my hands; and put out your hand, and place it in my side. Do not disbelieve, but believe." Thomas answered him, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said to him, "Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed." John 20: 24-29 (ESV)

As it has been well over a year since we have endured the COVID 19 pandemic. I use the word endured on purpose, as this is how it has seemed. How much longer is a question we may ask ourselves. If you are at all like me, the longer I wait the more questions I have. Doubt can creep into many areas of my thoughts.

Doubting Thomas, well that is how we often refer to him was the disciple who did not believe the message that Jesus had risen from the dead. He said he would not believe until Jesus physically appeared to him. Thomas was an original of the saying, I'll believe it when I see it.

Jesus eventually does come and show himself to Thomas, however in John 20: 26 tells us it was over one week after Jesus' resurrection. Eight days, can you imagine? Eight days of uncertainty and fear. Eight days of what will happen next? But in the waiting, there is a blessing. When Jesus does appear to Thomas, Jesus gives a promise to those who see and believe and also to those who believe without seeing. The promise is found in verse 29. Every day that passed without Thomas seeing proof was another opportunity for Thomas to believe by faith. Every time Thomas chose not to believe in the resurrection of Jesus was a missed blessing. Today, we have the opportunity to experience the very blessing Jesus described in verse 29. We who believe without having physically seen Jesus are blessed.

As we continue to wait be reminded that God is faithful.
