· Special Needs Assistance for Seniors Program payments are not considered income when calculating rent. A senior may receive one or more in a benefit year (July 1 - June 30) up to a maximum of \$5,000 per eligible senior or couple per benefit year.

· Management bodies can also access the pension information from the federal government's Income Security Programs website. OAS and GIS benefits are reviewed January, April, July, and October to reflect increases in cost of living as measured by the Consumer Price Index.
